

Privacy Policy for the iOS App “Phonochrome”

1. Controller

2. Purpose of the App

The iOS app *Phonochrome* allows users to convert a digital photo on their iPhone into a black-and-white negative, so it can be used in a traditional enlarger in the darkroom to create analogue prints.

3. Data Processing

3.1 Photos / Images

The app only processes photos that you explicitly select within the app.

The conversion (turning the image into a black-and-white negative) happens entirely on your device.

No photos or other personal data are transmitted to the developer or to any third party.

The developer does not store any of your photos in the cloud.

3.2 No User Profiles

The app does not create user profiles.

There is no tracking of your usage across apps or websites.

3.3 No Analytics or Advertising

The app does not use analytics tools (such as Google Analytics, Firebase Analytics, etc.).

The app does not display advertising and does not use advertising SDKs.

4. App Permissions

To provide its core functionality, the app may request the following permission:

Access to your photos / photo library

This permission is only used so you can select an image and have it converted into a negative.

The images are processed only within the app and are not sent to the developer or third parties.

You can revoke this permission at any time in the iOS settings of your device.

5. Disclosure of Data to Third Parties

No personal data is shared with third parties.

6. Legal Basis

To the extent that personal data within the meaning of the GDPR is processed (in particular images you select), the processing is based on Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR (performance of a contract), as the data processing is necessary to provide the functionality of the app.

7. Storage Period

The app does not store any personal data on servers controlled by the developer.

Processed images remain only on your device and are subject to your own settings for storage and deletion.

8. Your Rights

To the extent that personal data under the GDPR is concerned, you have the following rights:

Right of access (Art. 15 GDPR)

Right to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR)

Right to erasure (Art. 17 GDPR)

Right to restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR)

Right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR)

Right to object (Art. 21 GDPR)

To exercise these rights, please contact the controller using the contact details provided above.

You also have the right to lodge a complaint with a data protection supervisory authority if you believe that the processing of your personal data infringes the GDPR.
